- a. Discussion of Jardines De Rivera Subdivision, a new subdivision proposed for Plot ID: 18-07284
- City Manager: There were challenges getting the plot plan and drainage report to the City's engineers. Staff received communication from engineer earlier today with conclusion that subdivision packet is not complete. The engineer's report recommends a Pre-application Meeting with the developer and their engineer in accordance with Section 1 of the Sub-division Ordinance. It looks like there are some geotechnical investigation reports missing
  - o Staff recommends amending the Ordinance to have engineers involved earlier in this process.
  - The developer submitted a check for \$1,000. Engineer's report recommended a fee of \$4,800.
  - The engineer's report was emailed to commissioners. It recommends postponing this matter.
  - Commissioner Brumlow: Do the other commissioners recall at the last meeting we discussed amending this ordinance? We were going to do away with the pilot program part of it so that people coming to build subdivisions would not have to go through the public hearing for a variance. The last developer was asked to meet ADA compliance and we also requested a letter from them from the school district. We are not engineers; we do not know what to look for. It is a good idea we include them to tell us what is missing.
