7. ITEMS FROM THE FLOOR – PUBLIC COMMENTS

Ms. Yolanda Alvarez: Resident at 135 Anthony Dr. having problems with Zumba business (tenant). Noise complaint was placed with Anthony Police Department. Warning issued, but Zumba business had to

continue. City noise pollution ordinance is outdated. Requested the board to update ordinance to include a machine that can read the noise levels.

- Mayor Trujillo: Thank you, Ms. Álvarez for your input.
- Mr. Adrian Perez Emailed Projects Coordinator and Mayor. Requested Adams baseball field to be accessible for softball. Adams Park should be usable for choice of sport without excluding women. Current design does not accommodate softball. City should install features for both sports.
 - Mayor Trujillo: Thank you Mr. Perez; City manager will follow up on this.
- Mr. Ramon Esparza Petition for Adams Park; Many people use walking path to walk and exercise. The
 new park should have walking paths for residents. It should incorporate shade with benches to benefit
 residents also.
 - Mayor Trujillo: Thank you, Mr. Esparza
- Chief Ordonez Advocates for the amendment of noise ordinance. There should be safe exposure limits in the ordinance. Will present proposed changes to City manager to represent a more current version.

8. PRESENTATION

- a) Presentation of Capital Outlay and junior funds grants award. Presented by Representative Doreen Gallegos
- Representative Doreen Gallegos: Legislative session met this year via Zoom. Only legislators were allowed into the building. It was difficult talking to caucus members; Very hard to get information from one legislator to another. Anthony did very well on capital outlay.
 - Chief Ordonez did very well; This is a tribute to work she has done in this area. Representatives made sure she has the tools to continue keeping our community safe. Chief asked for \$20,000.00. Usually it's advisable to ask in increments of \$50,000. Two legislators placed two \$20,000.00 requests making it \$40,000.00. Representative Gallegos placed \$50,000 into Junior funds for police department, making it a total of \$90,000. These will help with speed monitors throughout the City. Stressed the junior money has to be spent first as it cannot be carried over.
 - Anthony Youth farm market structure- \$100,000 (These funds are under Dona Ana county)
 - Duffer Lane \$100,000.00
 - Anthony Parks & Recreation \$70,000
- b) Presentation of Safe Wise seventh annual Safest Cities report, Anthony NM as No.4 of the safest cities in New Mexico. *Presented by Chief of Police*
- Chief Ordonez Anthony in the top 10 safest cities; We moved from number 7 to number 4 this year. Safety is society's prime concern. What makes Anthony safe is a team effort from legislators, the community, local law enforcement, officers, staff and other stakeholders.
 - Trustee Flores Thank you Chief: You strive so high, which makes us safe.
 - **MPT Herrera** Thank you
 - Mayor Trujillo For the 11 years I've been with the city, I have not seen a Chief who does more administrative work and out in the field assisting officers.
- c) Presentation of Livesay & Acosta Street traffic study. Presented by Eric Hamilton Engineer PE, CFM
- Eric Hamilton: Traffic counters were placed at two separate locations along Acosta Road for a 120-hr period from 1/28/2021 to 2/2/2021 and along Livesay Street for a (72)-hour period from 1/25/2021 to 1/28/2021.

Recommendation:

- 1. Option No. 1: Traffic Control Devices to include Signage and Striping
- This option includes the implementation of speed limit regulatory and advisory signs including pavement markings such as speed limit marking and or 'SLOW DOWN' markings on the travel lane.
- 2. Option No. 2: Speed Humps: This option includes the implementation of designed speed humps; Typically, 12 feet in length along the vehicle travel path and 3 inches in height.
- Trustee Silva: Stops signs have been effective; The cost of speed bumps is high.
- **Eric Hamilton** Doesn't disagree. Most cost effective are stop signs. Four stop signs were just a starting point. It requires further analysis.
- Trustee Silva Acosta requires a lot more humps. Residents might claim wear and tear. Recommend we put stop signs to assist police officers. We are under-staffed.
- Trustee Gameros Agreed with Silva about stop signs.
- Trustee Gameros Suggested placing new line item in upcoming budget of \$33,000 for traffic calming.
