8. PRESENTATION

- a) Discussion 4th of July fireworks display. Presented by MPT Herrera & Mr. Jimmy Nevarez
 - MPT Herrera: Mr. Jimmy Nevarez, owner of Diablo Fireworks has very generously offered to do a fireworks presentation for the City at no cost, maybe at the soccer field.
 - Mr. Nevarez: We are licensed and have insurance, if you choose to have us do a display for you. We would need fire trucks on standby and police to guide traffic.
 - Trustee Flores: So, with that insurance, what you're saying is, that if anything went wrong, your insurance would cover it or is the city liable for any of this?
 - Mr. Nevarez: We have a minimum One-Million-dollar bond to cover accidents related to the firework's for personal injury.
 - Alan Dahl: Encouraged having a written agreement outlining the responsibilities of each party before the display. We should have a provision to indemnifying the City in the event of an accident.
 - Chief of Police: If approved, Chief will notify State police to request to officers, notify fire departments and other law enforcement around us.
 - Trustee Gameros: Chief to liaison with city manager to not put strain on officers.
 - Trustee Silva: Suggested Adams park: There is a hole in place.

- a. Consideration and action to approve proclamation of fireworks restrictions for year 2021.
 - MPT Herrera: I brought this up to make sure that everybody was aware that we do have to vote on a proclamation 20 days before July 4th.
 - Mayor Trujillo: We have had this proclamation approved before for some aerial fireworks like helicopter missiles.
 - Mr. Nevarez: Yes, Town of Mesilla passed the same proclamation. State does not allow over 150grams. If El Paso go to a total ban, we will have issues with Texans lighting these fireworks in the desert areas.

 - Trustee Gameros: If the city goes forward with the display vendors might protest the proclamation.

- d. Consideration and action to approve application for COPS Hiring Program (CHP) grant to hire two additional Patrol Officers for a three-year period. *Presented by Chief of Police*
 - Chief of Police: This grant opportunity has \$14 billion to go into community policing. The whole purpose of the program is to provide funding directly to agencies to hire or to re-hire additional law enforcement officers in an effort to increase the community policing capacity or the crime prevention efforts in our community. It would cover up to 75% of the entry level salary and the fringe benefits for each approved position for a total of three years. For full-time officers, there is a minimum of 25% of a local cash match requirement, unless there's a waiver approved.
 - Mayor Trujillo: I think it's a great idea, but the board can decide.
 - Trustee Gameros: If this passes, send a copy to finance officer to add to next year's budget.

 - GL:101-03-62401 was initially set aside for CES fee, due to COVID-19, these funds were not used.

g. Consideration and action to approve an amended temporary Covid-19 policies and procedures. Presented by City Manager

- City Manager: This item is staff's attempt to give employees some new guidance on policies and procedures related to the pandemic. Major changes are around paid sick leave, as well as the mass wearing, social distancing and vaccinations.
- Trustee Flores: Concerned that it says new hires must produce a COVID-19 vaccine record as a condition of employment.
- City Manager: Provisions are mostly to protect current employees.
- Alan Dahl City attorney: Public schools are used to having vaccine requirements to attend school. If you are going to require employees to be vaccinated, the current understanding is that you would have to be able to show that unvaccinated employees pose a direct threat to the health and safety of other individuals in the workplace. The county's current vaccine requirements are being challenged by at least one existing employee.
