

Sabina Lopez 1890 Land Grant

Proclamation

- Whereas, during the 18070's, a lady from Mexico settled in southern New Mexico territory and had a significant hand in the beginning of a new settlement eventually to be called "Anthony"; and
- Whereas, the lady was Sabina Lopez, formerly of Jimenez, Mexico, who homesteaded 145 acres of land where present day Anthony, New Mexico lies; and
- Whereas, after becoming part owner of Livesay Mercantile, she moved her family to an unclaimed plot of land some twenty miles northwest of El Paso; and
- Whereas, on August 4th, 1890, Sabina Lopez received ownership with a land grant issued by the General Land Office, specifically signed by the President of the United States, Benjamin A. Harrison; and
- Whereas, the desolate desert plot of land slowly turned into a farm, then a ranch, next a village, and finally the town of Anthony, New Mexico; and
- Whereas, the Lopez Family built a church; this chapel was to become the center-piece of the property and worshipers from miles around came for mass and catechism classes, the church was called "San Antonio's"; and
- Whereas, Sabina Lopez's niece, Albina, had the original copy of the land grant, which was later handed down to Mr. Carlos Tellez, who willfully sent the document to the City; and
- Whereas, this land grant is about 128 years old and Mr. Carlos Tellez had the document professionally unrolled and laminated, so as to provide the City with a great piece of history.

Now Therefore We, City of Anthony Board of Trustees, do hereby proclaim the day of August 4th, 2022, as Sabina Lopez 1890 Land Grant Day throughout the City of Anthony, NM.
