

## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF ANTHONY, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION: AND

DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the need exists within City of Anthony for neighborhood improvement projects in several low and moderate income neighborhoods, and the City of Anthony desires to apply to the Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for neighborhood improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has held two public hearings for public input and comment on February 5, 2020 during the 2020 application process; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that there is a significant need to undertake Acosta Road Improvements to provide adequate services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees determines that the Acosta Road Improvements meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANTHONY, NEW MEXICO, that

- 1. The City of Anthony is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for the Acosta Road Improvements;
- 2. That the Board of Trustees directs and designates the Mayor as the City of Anthony's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the New Mexico Community Development Block Grant Program;
- 3. The City of Anthony officials and staff are directed to do any and all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution;

- 4. Per the CDBG program, the City of Anthony is required to submit an application for a full and phased version of the project.
  - a. That the Full project grant application request amount is \$750,000 and the City of Anthony will commit the required cash match of \$75,000 for the Acosta Road Improvements;
  - b. That the Phased project grant application request amount is \$650,000 and the City of Anthony will commit the required cash match of \$65,000 for the Acosta Road Improvements.
