

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ANTHONY, NEW MEXICO AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSING TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC OF NM 460, FROM ACOSTA ROAD TO THE NM/TX STATE LINE, ON JULY 4, 2022 FROM 10:00AM TO 1:00PM FOR THE PURPOSE OF A 4TH OF JULY PARADE EVENT.

WHEREAS; The 2021 New Mexico Statutes, Chapter 66 - Motor Vehicles, Article 7 - Traffic Laws; Signs, Signals and Markings; Accidents; Weight and Size; Traffic Safety, Part 1 - APPLICATION OF TRAFFIC LAWS, Section 66-7-9 - Powers of local authorities, grants the municipalities reasonable exercise of police power; and

WHEREAS; The Town of Anthony, TX, is the special event sponsor, and is submitting an application in accordance with the New Mexico Department of Transportation (hereinafter District) *Rules and Regulations for Special Events, Civic Functions, or Filming on Highways*; and

WHEREAS; Traffic control and emergency/incident management plans will be required for all activities regardless of the level of impact but the level of detail will be based on the extent of the impacts to the traveling public as determined by the District; and

WHEREAS; The City of Anthony, NM will provide local law enforcement and temporary traffic control staffing and equipment with the City limits; and

WHEREAS; the Governance Body finds it in the public interest to authorize the temporary closing to vehicular traffic on NM 460 from Acosta Road to the NM/TX state line;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNANCE BODY OF THE CITY OF ANTHONY, NEW MEXICO:

That the Governance Body hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to support and coordinate with the Town of Anthony, TX and the District, in the permitting, temporary traffic control operation, and incident management of the 2022 4th of July special event parade.
