## City of Anthony Acosta Road

The Acosta Road project was funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, which addresses infrastructure needs and promotes stronger/more resilient communities. The City of Anthony applied for and received the maximum CDBG grant award of \$750,000, accompanied by a 10% City contribution of \$75,000 for the final design, construction, construction administration, and observation of Acosta Road from Anthony Drive to 4th Street. The scope of improvements provided community-friendly roadway and drainage improvements, including full-depth roadway reconstruction, curb & gutter, sidewalks, resident driveways, signing & striping, and drainage improvements.


